PROCESSING WOOL Fact Sheet

If the batch of wool is of coarser fiber and shorter staple length (three inches or less), the machinery gently twists the slivers into ropelike strands called “roving,” and winds the roving into balls ready for spinning into woolen yarns If the batch is of finer fiber and longer staple length (longer than three

How Much Yarn Do I Need - My Yarn Shop

How Much Yarn Do I Need? This chart shows the average quantity of yarn needed to knit an average adult-sized long-sleeved pullover or cardigan by chest measurements (it allows for 2 inches of wearing ease in the finished sweater Allow 20% less for short-sleeved sweaters Allow 30% less for sleeveless or children’s garments

Measurements & Sizes OVERSIZED CABLE SWEATER

Wool, shade 33 Teddy, 2 (3) 400g balls Needles: 5mm, plus spare needle Cable needle Stitch holders Tapestry needle Tension Square 1 16 sts x 21 rows 1 10cm x 10cm 1 stocking stitch 1 5mm needles Special Abbreviations C4F: sl two sts onto cn, hold at front of work, k2, k2 from cn C6F: sl three sts onto cn, hold at front of work, k3, k3 from cn

Felted Dryer Balls

Roll 2 1/2-inch balls from a skein of 100% wool yarn Skein sizes may vary, but most will yield three to four balls Step 2 Thread the end of one ball onto a yarn needle Unroll approximately 18 inches Stitch the end randomly through the ball until you can take no more stitches Cut off the tail Repeat with the remaining balls Step 3
